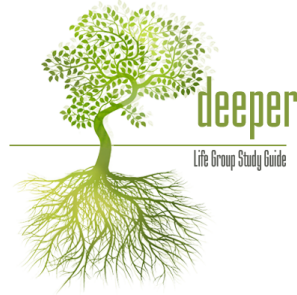


Deeper Questions

6. Read Philippians 1:27-28... What does it mean to live a life worthy of the Gospel?

7. What do you need to do so that your life is worthy of the Gospel? If you do that, what impact would you expect to see?
