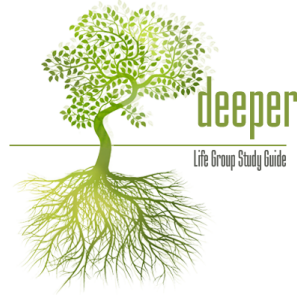


## Deeper Questions

2. Read Romans 14:1-4... In Rome they were arguing over food. What are some of the disputable matters we face today?
3. Why is Paul so adamant about not judging others? Who does the Church judge today?
4. When it comes to disputable matters (issues not directly mentioned in the Bible) how should we handle those issues?

5. Read Galatians 6:1-2... What is the difference between judging and helping to restore? How can we use grace and truth to help someone in their sin?

6. Should there be a difference in how we point to truth with a Christian we know and a person we don't know? How can you point out sin in other's lives without judging them? Look at Jesus for example.

7. Read Romans 14:13... In what ways are we stumbling blocks to others? How can you not be a stumbling block to those around?
