Welcome (You to Me, Me to You)

1. Would you rather work at things alone or be part of a team? Why? What are the benefits and downfalls of each?

Worship (Us to God)

1. Read John 15:18-25... Pray in groups of 2-3 that God will use this group to make each other bold in their faith.

Word (God to Us)

- 1. Why did you decide to follow Christ?
- 2. As a church we are Elevating our capacity for ministry. Individually we should be doing the same. We are all in a place where we can have an unique influence on those around us. Who in your life do you have an unique influence in? Could be coworkers, neighbors, extended family, etc... How do you use that influence?
- 3. Read Luke 15:1-7... Why would Jesus leave his other sheep, risking them, to save the one lost one?
- 4. How does this parable impact you, that Jesus would leave all the others to come find you when you are lost? And that Jesus is always looking for those that are lost?

- 5. Read Luke 10:1-4... Jesus sends his people out rather urgently and without much training or instruction. Jesus not only models the previous parable with his own life but instructs us to do so as well. Why do you think he says the "harvest is plentiful but the workers are few"? Have you seen this to be true in your experiences?
- 6. What does it mean for us to go out into the harvest field? What might be some of the difficulties we would face?
- 7. Why do you think Jesus sent them out in pairs and not by themselves? How does that apply to what we do in context of this Life Group and our Church?
- 8. What can we do to better support each other throughout the week as we go out like "sheep among wolves"?

Response (Us to the World)

1. Pray for God to raise up more workers to go into your neighborhoods, workplaces, and community groups. And pray that God will open doors for each other to reach those that are lost.
