


Life Group Questions

Skeptics Wanted: Jesus is the Only Way May 15th, 2016



Welcome (You to Me, Me to You)

1. When did you get caught in a mistruth or a lie?

Worship (Us to God)

1. Read 1 Peter 5:6-11... We come with our worries, concerns, questions, and doubts. Peter says that we can cast all of our baggage on God because He cares. Take a moment to pray and focus on God. Offering short prayers casting your anxieties on Him and praising Him because He cares.

Word (God to Us)

1. How does the world think you get to heaven? What affects does this belief have on how they live their lives?
2. Divide up the following scripture and have one person read each passage: John 14:6, John 3:16, John 3:36, Matthew 7:13-14, Matthew 10:32-33... What did we learn from each of these passages?
3. Jesus says He is the ONLY way. In other words if you don't believe in Him you are wrong. Why did Jesus make such a bold statement? Do you think this was harsh or loving? How do you respond to this truth? Does the world like this truth?
4. If Jesus is the only way to heaven, how should our lives reflect that truth? What should look different?

5. Read Acts 4:1-12... Peter and John believed that Jesus was the only way. How did it change how they lived their life?
6. How does the truth of Christ change how you interact with your neighbors, coworkers, and families?
7. What impact will living your life make on those around you? (Friends, family, kids, spouse, neighbors, etc...)
8. How can living out the truth of Christ impact those around you?

Response (Us to the World)

1. Who do you have in your life that you can make an impact on this week? How can you be bold in love and practically share the love of Christ?
