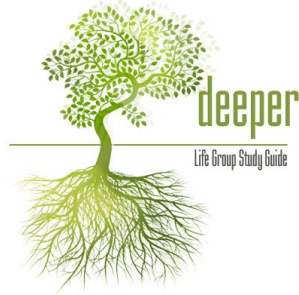


Deeper Questions

Revolutionary: Was Jesus Revolutionary? 10/9/16



Welcome (You to Me, Me to You)

What is your favorite historical period? Why?

Worship (Us to God)

Read Isaiah 55:8-13... Often we approach God and try to make sense of His doings. Spend a few moments praying that God will show you His ways in your life.

Word (God to Us)

1. What does it take for someone to be revolutionary? Think of a few revolutionary people. What do they have in common?
2. Read Matthew 5:43-48... What does Jesus teach us that is revolutionary about how we treat our enemies? How is this different than what the world does?
3. Read Matthew 6:5-8... What does Jesus teach us that is revolutionary about how we can interact with God? How should this passage change how you and I pray?
4. Jesus taught us a new way of interacting with God and the world. What keeps you from living this revolutionary way?

5. Read John 15:9-17... According to John 15, what is the purpose of Jesus' revolution? What must we do to be a part of Jesus' revolution?
6. According to John, if we follow Jesus' revolution we will bear fruit. What kind of fruit should your life be producing?
7. Jesus revolutionized how we interact with God and the world. How does this directly affect your life? What in your life do you need to change so that it matches up with the revolution Jesus started?
8. If you were to be fully committed, what fruit would you expect in your life?
