Welcome (You to Me, Me to You)

Share a time when you felt like you didn't have voice or were marginalized.

Worship (Us to God)

Read Psalm 72:1-4... God will judge with righteousness and rescue the afflicted. Spend time praising God who responds to injustice in your life and in our world.

Word (God to Us)

1. What makes someone marginalized? Who in our society is marginalized?
2. Read Proverbs 14:31... How do our actions towards someone show contempt or honor toward God?
3. If we have the opportunity to help the poor or stand up for injustice and do nothing, what are we communicating to God? What roadblocks to being "kind" do you experience?
4. Read Luke 4:14-21... According to this passage what was Jesus' mission? Why is His mission important? How is this revolutionary to the perceived mission of the Messiah?

5. Jesus' ministry focused on reaching the marginalized and giving a voice to the voiceless. Does the Church today still continue that ministry? In what ways? How can we follow Jesus' example of caring for the marginalized today?
6. Read Proverbs 21:13... Why do you think God says to care for others so much? What in your life needs to change so that you have the same heart?
7. Earlier we talked about who was marginalized in our society. How can you speak up for the marginalized?

Response (Us to the World)

What are some practical ways we as a life group and church can reach the marginalized? Spend some time praying that God will show you people in your life that are marginalized. Ask Him to give you a voice to speak up for them.
